

Announcement: new position available in adolescent health research

The Research Group on Adolescent Health (GRSA) at the University Institute of Social and Preventive Medicine (Centre Hospitalier Universitaire Vaudois and University of Lausanne) is looking for a senior researcher in adolescent health (part-time, 50%).

Date of opening: February 2010. This position will remain open until a suitable candidate is found.

Starting date: as soon as possible.

Required qualifications: qualified candidates must have a good experience in adolescent health research, good methodological skills, a good peer-reviewed publication record and excellent scientific writing skills. An excellent English level (written and spoken) is necessary. Knowledge in qualitative research would be a plus.

Description of duties: to develop research protocols;
to manage projects autonomously;
to supervise junior members of the research group;
to represent the research group if needed.

Salary: commensurate with experience and academic rank, according to the standards of the institution.
