

## **SAGS Research Networks – Guideline**

The SAGS promotes the creation of thematic networks that contribute to the stimulation of research collaborations between universities and regions as well as to the anchoring, networking, and development of gender studies research in Switzerland. These research networks are of central importance to our society: they reflect scientifically and socially significant topics in the field of gender studies, while they also provide the opportunity to raise new issues and theoretical approaches and thus anticipate innovative and cutting-edge research and societal transformations. Because of their significance, SAGS supports the research networks in many ways.

### **Financial support**

The SAGS provides financial support to the research networks. The SAGS budget currently allows for financial support of a maximum of 500 CHF per year per research network. The funds can be used to organize scientific events or projects relevant to the research interests of the network. To receive this financial support, please send a project plan (approximately 1 page) and a budget to [info@genregeschlecht.ch](mailto:info@genregeschlecht.ch). The SAGS board will decide on the approval of your proposal.

Research networks wishing to plan larger scientific events can apply for additional funding from the Swiss Academy of Humanities and Social Sciences. Please note that SAGW/ASSH funding requests have to be submitted by March 1<sup>st</sup> for the subsequent year (i.e., funding for events in 2025 must be submitted by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024). Please contact the SAGS secretary ([info@genregeschlecht.ch](mailto:info@genregeschlecht.ch)) well ahead of time to coordinate your funding request.

### **Visibility: newsletter, website and social media**

#### Newsletter

Research networks have the opportunity to communicate events and news via the SAGS electronic newsletter: *Bulletin SSEG-SGGF*. The newsletter is published three times per year, usually in late February, late June, and late November.

Please provide a brief description of the activity you wish to share (in French and/or German), and if available an image of a flyer/leaflet, or call etc. Deadlines for including your material in the newsletter are: February 15<sup>th</sup>, June 15<sup>th</sup>, November 15<sup>th</sup>.

#### Website

The SAGS publishes a short profile of all its research networks on its website. Send your description and a list of members to [info@genregeschlecht.ch](mailto:info@genregeschlecht.ch). Please check at least once a year whether the description is still up to date.

#### Social Media
